



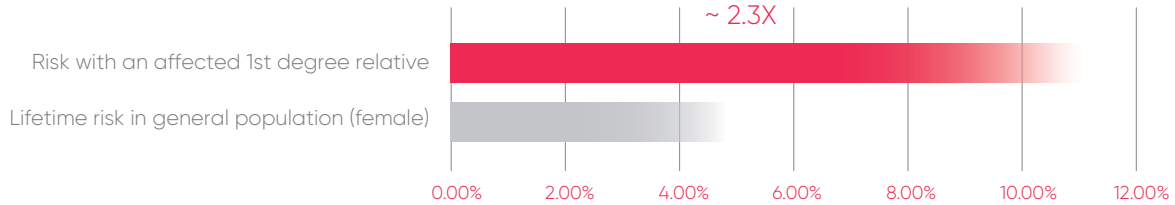

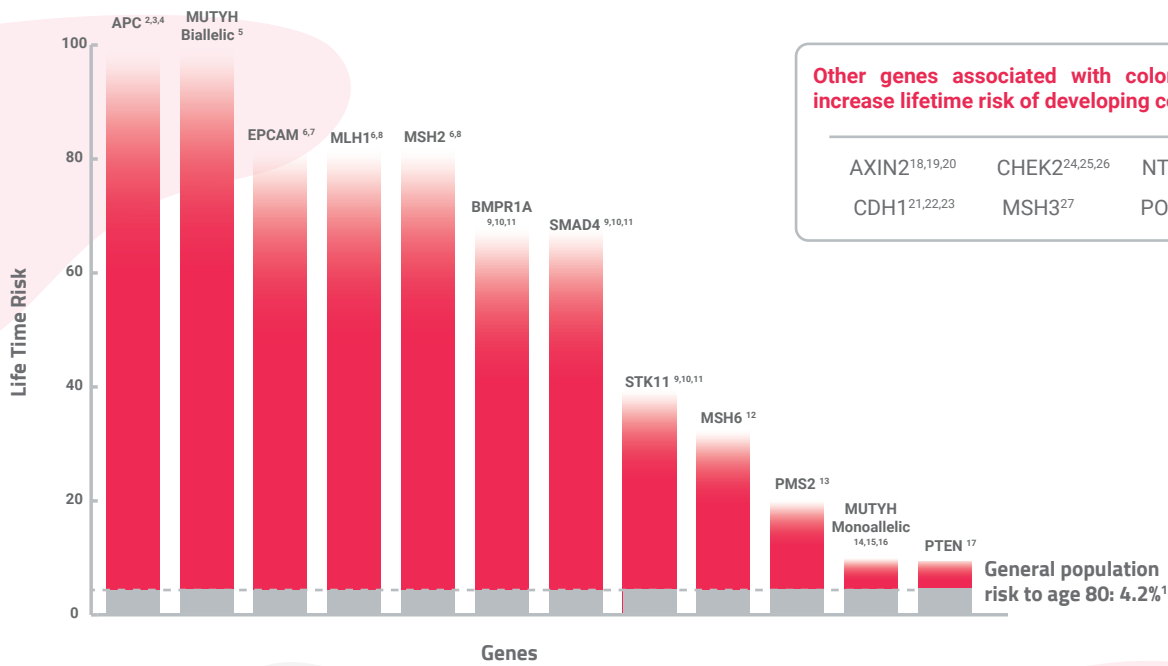

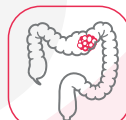

## Recommended Preventive Interventions



Colorectal surgical evaluation for appropriate patients



Colonoscopy starting at 20 to 25 years, (or 2 to 5 y younger than the earliest Dx in family if it is under age 25), every 1-2 years.



Aspirin for risk reduction
