



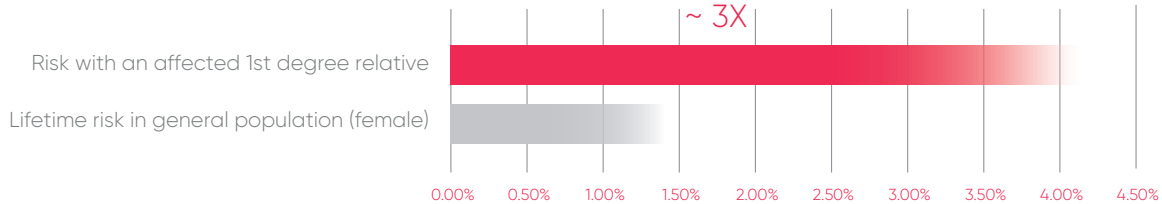

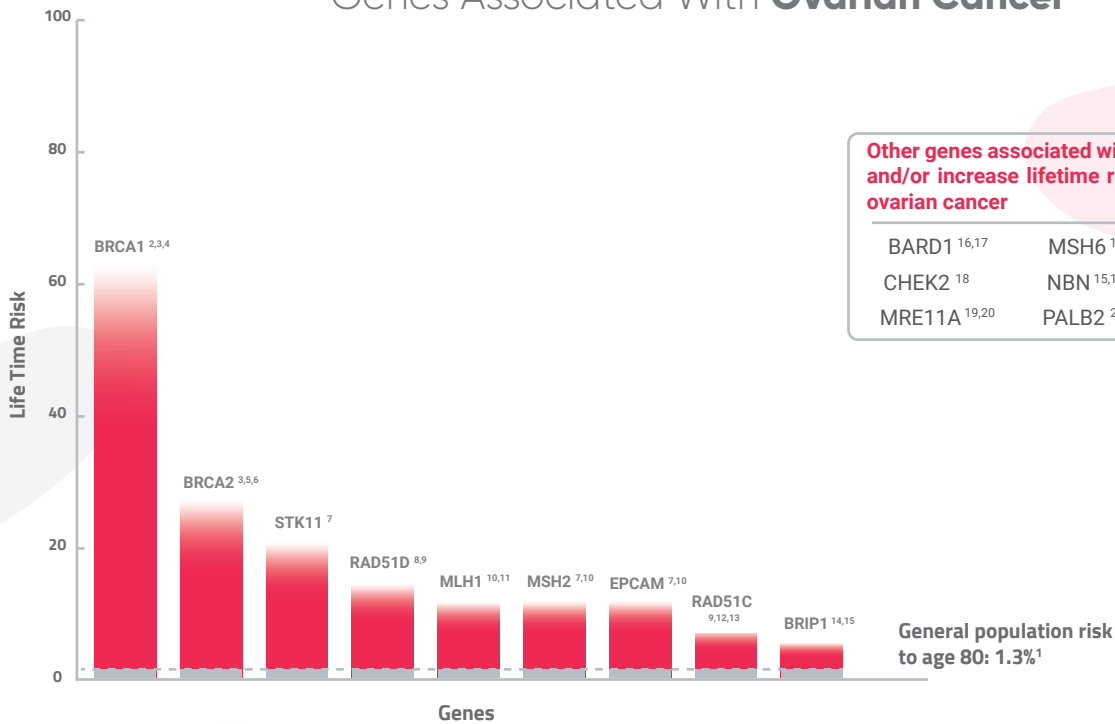

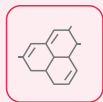
Genes Associated With Ovarian Cancer
